Citizen Comments:

- Mrs. Paula Borsch stated 24 hours notice is required prior to the start of a Special Meeting, and there had not been 24 hours notice for tonight's meeting.

 - Following Mrs. Borsch's comments about the requirement to advertise a special meeting, Board Solicitor Donald Fetzko asked the Board Secretary Michael Bichko if the special meeting had been advertised. Mr. Bichko replied that he had been directed by the Superintendent's office at approximately 10:30 a.m. on Monday, April 17, 2006, to advertise a special meeting for the evening of April 18, 2006. The notice was faxed to the Daily News since their advertising cutoff was 11:00 a.m. The advertisement was also placed on the district's website and a written notice was placed at the entrance to each school building.
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- Mr. Fetzko stated the the described action was not sufficient notice and there could be no special meeting.
- Mrs. Terrick announced that representatives from the County would be present at Munhall Borough Council Chambers on April 19, 2006, at 6:30 p.m. to present a proposal for the use of TIF funds which remain in the TIF account from the original bond issue. The contractor on the bridge construction has requested that these funds be given to him as a bonus to accelerate the completion of the project. The school district receives approximately 56% of the TIF revenue but has no representation on the TIF Board. The County and each municipality have a representative. There was additional discussion on the possibility of contacting Attorney Albert Maiello on auditing the TIF, but the expense may be prohibitive.
- Mrs. Terrick requested explanation of the following invoices: P 108 PA Coach, W 142 Warren exp., Burt Hill invoices, question on crossing guard payment. Mr. Bichko responded with the explanations.


