

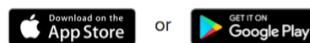

FAQ GRADUATION

- 1. Starting sometime in November, graduates will be called to room 202 to verify the spelling of their name as it will appear on their diploma. They will also be asked to give their height and weight for their gown.**
- 2. On December 12 during period 7, all senior students will be called to the auditorium for a meeting with a representative from Balfour. At this time, each senior will receive a packet from Balfour which contains an order form for graduation announcements. The orders will be collected in January. Parents can also order directly from the Balfour website. *(There were many seniors who neglected to take this packet home and were unable to order announcements, so please don't delay in placing your order!)***
3. The 2018 Graduation Ceremony will be held on Friday, June 8, 2018 at 7:00pm.
4. The location of graduation is Campbell Field—weather permitting. In the event of rain, the ceremony will be held in the High School gymnasium. This will be determined by 1:00pm on June 8th.
5. You are not limited to the number of guests that attend the ceremony. We do not use tickets for graduation.
6. Special Parking Passes (handicap) will be available in the Activities office starting the last week in May.
7. Since parking at Campbell Field is limited, the district does provide a shuttle service to Campbell Field starting at 5:30pm from the High School.
8. There is no charge for caps and gowns. These are provided to each graduate by the district. Additional tassels can be purchased through Balfour.
9. Caps and gowns will not be distributed to any senior with an outstanding obligation.
10. Caps and gowns, as well as honor cords, will be distributed to the seniors following the Senior Breakfast.
11. Class rank is determined at the completion of the third nine weeks grading period.
12. In order to walk in the Graduation Ceremony, all seniors are required to attend the indoor and outdoor practices.
