

Special Education

The Steel Valley School District provides a full range of services and program options to eligible students. The various options in the district range from supportive intervention in the regular classroom to full-time special education support outside of the regular education classroom, depending on the individual needs of the student. Inclusive intervention practices are the first step in the continuum of placement options. If a placement option is not available within the District to meet the student's needs, then services are secured from the Allegheny Intermediate Unit, another school district, a licensed private academic day school, an approved private school or a community agency. Placement options provide for a free and appropriate public education for all eligible students. The District also provides such related services as speech and language therapy, occupational therapy, physical therapy, nursing services, psychological services, social work services, and paraprofessional support.

The following programs are provided with the District:

Learning Support, Emotional Support, Elementary Autistic Support, Secondary Life Skills Support, Speech and Language Support, and Gifted Support.
