
Pick a way to receive messages for **SV Seniors 2019**:

Follow the instructions to sign up for Remind. You'll be prompted to download the mobile app.




B If you don't have a smartphone, get text notifications.

Tentative Dates: (sometimes these dates must be changed)

- Friday, September 7, 2018 – “Intent to Run” forms must be submitted to Mrs. McCallister if you wish to run for a Senior Class Officer Position.
- Friday, September 14, 2018 – Senior Class Officer elections during period 1 (period 4 for seniors who attend Steel Center)
- Usually sometime in January – Senior Class snow tubing trip to Hidden Valley (pending superintendent & school board approval)
- Usually sometime in March/April – Senior Class trip to Splash Lagoon Waterpark (pending superintendent & school board approval)

FAQ GRADUATION

1. The 2019 Graduation Ceremony will be held on Thursday, June 6, 2019 at 7:00 pm. (Seniors should be at the graduation site by 6:00 pm)
2. The location of graduation is Campbell Field—weather permitting. In the event of rain, the ceremony will be held in the High School gymnasium. This will be determined by 1:00 pm on June 6th.
3. You are not limited to the number of guests that attend the ceremony. We do not use tickets for graduation.
4. Special Parking Passes (handicap) will be available in the Activities office starting the last week in May.
5. Since parking at Campbell Field is limited, the district does provide a shuttle service to Campbell Field starting at 5:30 pm from the High School.
6. There is no charge for caps and gowns. These are provided to each graduate by the district. Additional tassels can be purchased through Balfour.
7. Starting at the end of September, Mrs. Besh will call each graduate to room 202 to verify the spelling of his/her name as it will appear on the diploma. They will also be asked to give their height and weight for their gown.
8. In December, all seniors will be called to the auditorium for a meeting with a representative from Balfour. At this time, each senior will receive a packet from Balfour which contains an order form for graduation announcements. The orders will be collected in January. Parents can also order directly from the Balfour website. *(There were many seniors who neglected to take this packet home and were unable to order announcements, so please don't delay in placing your order!)*
9. Caps and gowns will not be distributed to any senior with an outstanding obligation.
10. Caps and gowns, as well as honor cords, will be distributed to the seniors following the Senior Breakfast.
11. Class rank is determined at the completion of the third nine weeks grading period.
12. In order to walk in the Graduation Ceremony, all seniors are required to attend the indoor and outdoor practices.
